This past January, the Hope Foundation of the Mahoning Valley hosted the Game of Hope Charity Basketball Classic at YSU's Beeghly Center in conjunction with area TV stations 27 First News & FOX Youngstown; WYTV & MyYTV; radio stations 95.9 KISS-FM, MIX 98.9, & News Radio 570 WKBN, Accent Media, UAW Locals 1112 & 1714, NEOEA (North Eastern Ohio Education Association) and the Lamar Advertising Company. About 750 people were in attendance for the game. The game was taped and will be broadcasted this Sunday, February 21, 2010 @ 8pm.
